

# UC Davis Eivind Lange Fellowships

*The Eivind Lange Fellowships are for graduate students to help support them with conducting research in Chile in partnership with UC Davis Chile Life Sciences Innovation Center*

**\$12,000 in Grants Available for 2022-2023 Deadline: October 31, 2022**

## Overview

UC Davis established the UC Davis Chile Life Sciences Innovation Center (UC Davis Chile) in Santiago, Chile in 2015 to advance science and technology through collaborative research between UC Davis and Chilean investigators, extend knowledge from California to Chile through extension/outreach activities, and strengthen the historical relationship between Chile and California. ## Eligibility

Eivind Lange Fellowships are offered to highly motivated graduate students conducting research relevant to the mission of UC Davis Chile. Funds may be used to cover expenses related to a recipient's area of study, including, but not limited to, research and travel.

Eivind Lange Fellowships are limited to **a maximum of \$4,000**, to be completed prior to December 1, 2023.

Applicants must be enrolled UC Davis graduate students and in good academic standing.

## Submission Details

Applicants are required to submit a proposal and a letter of recommendation using the following online application form:

Proposals should include:

- Description of research issue and its importance
- Relationship to Chile and UC Davis Chile Life Sciences Innovation Center
- Outline of research goals and anticipated outcomes
- Outline of theory and methodology
- Budget (airfare, lodging, transportation, supplies, etc.)

Limit proposal to four pages, double-spaced, 12 font type, one-inch margins.

The letter of recommendation should be written by a faculty mentor/advisor and should describe how the activities in Chile will help the candidate's academic studies, research, and future career goals.

Applications will be evaluated by a faculty panel. Fellowship awardees will be announced in December 2022.

The deadline for submission is October 31, 2022.
