Description:

We will be stationed in the Yangtze Delta Area – the birthplace of silk and now the hub of modern fashion and textile production in China. With easy access to Shanghai and many other famous historical textile sites, students will visit museums to study Chinese traditional costumes and their influence on global fashion development, as well as take field trips to the factories where many internationally recognized fashion brands are made to investigate the latest apparel and textile facilities. With a flexible summer schedule, students can shop at textile markets, interact with local designers and dealers, visit the famous oriental gardens in the region, or relax in town to observe the lifestyles where the deep roots of Chinese civilization meet western influence.

- O Exploration of materials, embellishments, and structural techniques in wearable objects derived from historical and contemporary world cultures.
- O Understand how these factors influence, and provide a context for, the development of design thinking.
- O Emphasis on unique qualities of individual expression applied to textiles and fashion design.
- O In-depth understanding of the fashion industry that is related to many levels of social and technological impact.

Logistics:

The course consists of lectures, sketchbook assignments, and group projects and discussions. Class meets regularly on weekdays from 9:30 am to noon unless there are off-campus field trips arranged (see schedule). To work in class is a requirement. In addition to the time in class, students will be expected to work outside of class for sketchbook assignments, design journals and group projects. If you arrive late or must miss class (for an extraordinary reason) you are responsible for reporting to the on-site coordinator and the instructor. As a courtesy to everyone, please keep yourself accountable and arrive on time. You will be expected to use lab time for teamwork — this will feed into your team participation grade. Time will also be scheduled for individual evaluation and consultation with students in afternoons and evenings.

- O Summer Session is short and intense. No late project/s will be graded after the program is dismissed.
