Call for 2020-2021 Proposals: UC Davis Study Abroad Faculty-led Programs

TRADITIONAL SUMMER ABROAD PROGRAMS

[Summer Abroad](#) programs are 4 weeks long and 8 units of academic credit led and taught onsite by UC Davis faculty. Programs include a core course and a Directed Group Study 198; the latter focuses on site visits, excursions and field work. Programs typically occur within the time frames of Summer Session I or Summer Session II.

For this cycle Study Abroad is interested in proposals for all locations, including programs that travel to more than one location.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Instructions for the proposal Study Abroad packet can be found on the Global Learning Hub website under [Faculty](#). Academic Senate and Academic Federation faculty with faculty appointments, as well as retired faculty are eligible to lead programs. Faculty are expected to have prior familiarity with the site and communities.

All proposals must have department approval in the form of a brief letter of endorsement from the department Chair/program Director.

FACULTY COMPENSATION AND SUPPORT

- Travel to/from program site, and all onsite expenses for lodging, meals, local travel and incidentals (subject to campus policies);
- Recruitment and Student Support payment for non-instructional responsibilities on site;
- Instructional salary based on number of students enrolled in program.

Program proposals are reviewed by the Program Proposal Committee. If a proposal is selected for development, faculty will be expected to begin developing their programs immediately after being notified in May 2020.
